Middle-Level Grading Incentive Procedure/Policy
EXTENDED DAY

In an effort to recruit and sustain student participants in the Extended Day Comprehensive Remediation Program, a Grading “Extra Credit” Incentive will be awarded.

The Afterschool (“**Extra Credit**”) Grade will account for **20%** of the students’ final grade each reporting period. This “extra credit” will be added into the corresponding, Regular School Day course the student participates in during the Extended Day sessions. For example, if the student participates in ELA, Math, Science and Social Studies Remediation, participation in the Afterschool Program merits them “extra credit” in each of these Regular School Day content area courses. If a student only participates in ELA, he/she is only able to receive “extra credit” in the ELA regular school day course.

The Calculation Model is outlined below:

Example: Student’s Regular School Day Grade = 80

Student’s Extended Day (CRP Scholars) Grade = 90

FORMULA:

(Regular School Day Grade x .80) + (CRP Extended Day Grade x .20) =
Report Card Grade of 82.)

For your convenience, an excel spreadsheet with this formula is attached for your use.

Please note the following:

- Afterschool/Extended Day “Extra Credit” is used **ONLY** to support/help the student with his/her regular school day grade.
- If the Afterschool/Extended Day class average grade is **lower** than the Regular School Day average, then the “Extra Credit” should not be granted. This regulation will prevent the adverse impact of grade average reduction.
- Afterschool/Extended Day “Extra Credit” can not be used to enhance a student’s grade more than 1 letter grade higher.
